

Thinking of hosting a *Girls on Board Training Event*?

You provide the space and food in return for FREE training for your staff.

Here is what you need to know:

- Training takes the whole day; we start with registration and refreshments at 9:30 and the training itself starts at 10:00. The day ends at 3:30
- You need to provide a space for up to 35 teachers to train, with Audio Visual equipment and a PC computer connected to it.
- Space for the same people to watch me deliver a 45-50min session to a class of around 20 to 25 girls; that could be the same space, it doesn't matter.
- A class of girls, preferably from Years 8 or 9 (but Years 5 to 7 is also fine). Class size preferably 15 – 25, but up to 30 is fine.
- Tea/coffee on arrival and again mid-morning.
- Lunch for all the trainees.

You provide the above in return for **8 free places** for your teachers. (I don't mind if you give up to four of your free places away to local state schools, but preferably not to independent schools - who could have paid for themselves!) Each place is worth £200, so it is a good deal!

I expect you to help with selling the other 27 places at the event - contacting your network and encouraging schools you know to attend.
